53rd ANNUAL BLUEWATER TOURNAMENT RULES

May 7 - 11, 2024

Northeast Florida Marlin Association Clubhouse – Camachee Cove Yacht Harbor

PART 1 - GENERAL FISHING RULES AND PROCEDURES

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES:

- 1. Boats may depart from St. Augustine, Mayport, or Ponce Inlets.
- 2. Departure is permitted at any time on the declared fishing day.

FISHING DAYS AND HOURS:

- 3. Boats must declare their fishing days via the tournament app by 9:00 PM the day before. Changes must be texted to (904) 545-9048 by this deadline.
- 4. **Lines In:** 7:30 AM | **Lines Out:** 3:30 PM (subject to modification due to weather). A minimum of four hours of fishing constitutes a full fishing day.
- 5. Teasers are not permitted in the water before "Lines In."

EXTENSIONS:

- 6. Boats hooked up within the last 15 minutes must notify a committee boat before "Lines Out."
- 7. If a fish remains hooked past "Lines Out," notification must be sent via VHF Channel 72 or text. In the absence of confirmation, a video with timestamp and GPS must be provided.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES:

- 8. Boats with fish to weigh or released billfish must proceed directly to the weigh station at St. Augustine Inlet.
- 9. All boats must check in via VHF Channel 72 when abeam of the St. Augustine Sea Buoy by 6:00 PM unless granted an extension.
- 10. Boats not returning to St. Augustine must check in via text if they have no fish to weigh or releases to report.
- 11. Gamefish weighed will be used for the Friday night fish fry.

WEATHER:

- 12. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel fishing due to unsafe conditions. If a NOAA "Small Craft Advisory" or greater is posted for the 20-60 mile forecast, fishing will be canceled for that day. "Small Craft Exercise Caution" does not automatically cancel fishing.
- 13. If a fishing day is canceled post "Lines In," all boats must cease fishing and return to port. Extensions for ongoing fights will be granted per the tournament rules.
- 14. "Go/No-Go" decisions will be made by 4:00 AM on fishing days.

PART 2 - SPECIFIC FISHING RULES - BILLFISH DIVISION

TACKLE & BAIT REGULATIONS:

- 1. IGFA rules apply unless otherwise specified.
- 2. Rod passing is permitted **only once** after initial hook-up.
- 3. Wire lines and electric reels are prohibited.
- 4. Live bait is permitted.
- 5. Only non-offset circle hooks are allowed with natural bait. J-hooks are permitted with artificial lures
- 6. Leader length is limited to 30 feet.

SIZE LIMITS:

7. Blue Marlin must exceed **105 inches** (measured from lower jaw to fork of tail). Smaller fish will not be weighed and remain the responsibility of the captain.

BILLFISH RELEASE PROCEDURES:

- 8. All billfish releases must be reported immediately via VHF Channel 72.
- 9. Photo or video evidence with timestamp and identifiable species is required for release points. Failure to provide this evidence will result in default sailfish points.

PART 3 - GAMEFISH DIVISION RULES

- 1. Only rod and reel fishing is permitted. Electric reels are prohibited.
- 2. Downriggers, planers, and wire lines are allowed. No line restrictions.
- 3. Once a gamefish is hooked, the rod may be passed **once** before angling must be completed.
- 4. Mutilated fish (damaged by sharks, mammals, or propellers) will be disqualified. The Tournament Committee has sole discretion.

PART 4 - SCORING SYSTEM

BILLFISH DIVISION POINTS:

• Blue Marlin: 400 points

• White Marlin: 200 points

• Spearfish: 200 points

• Sailfish: 125 points

• Swordfish: 200 points

Tie-breakers: First to accumulate points wins.

GAMEFISH DIVISION POINTS:

- 1 point per pound (Dolphin, Wahoo, Tuna).
- Two fish of each species may be weighed per day; heaviest two will determine winners.

PART 5 - TOURNAMENT CONDUCT & PROTESTS

- 1. Substitute boats must be registered if an original vessel becomes disabled.
- 2. Boats under tow post "Lines In" are disqualified for that day. Self-repairs may continue fishing.
- 3. Protest must be submitted in writing with a \$500 cash fee before weigh station closure. If upheld, the fee is refunded.

PART 6 - DISQUALIFICATION & POLYGRAPH

- 1. Unsportsmanlike conduct or rule violations may result in single-day or full tournament disqualification. No refunds.
- 2. Random polygraph testing may be required. Failure to comply results in full team disqualification with forfeited prizes.

PART 7 - PRIZES & AWARDS

BILLFISH DIVISION PRIZES:

- 1. **Overall:** Top boats with most accumulated points (released and boated).
- 2. Lady Angler: Highest-scoring female angler.
- 3. **Junior Angler:** Highest-scoring angler (16 & under).

GAMEFISH DIVISION PRIZES:

- 1. **Overall:** Top boats with most points (Dolphin, Wahoo, Tuna).
- 2. Lady Angler: Highest-scoring female angler.
- 3. **Junior Angler:** Highest-scoring angler (16 & under).

All final decisions rest with the **Tournament Committee**. Any changes will be announced at the **Captain's Meeting**. The ultimate responsibility for vessel safety lies with the **captain**.
